

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CRIMINOLOGY CERTIFICATE

DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY

The University-conferred Certificate in Criminology is awarded to Sociology Majors who have included criminology-specific courses among their elective Sociology and allied credits.

One course is required: **SOC 3561**- Criminology (3 credit hours).
