

## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DIVERSITY CERTIFICATE

### Department of Sociology

The University-conferred Certificate in Diversity is awarded to Sociology Majors who have included diversity-specific courses among their elective Sociology and Allied credits.

**ONE (1) course is REQUIRED: SOC 3380 Race, Ethnicity, Class, and Gender (3 cr hrs).**

**NINE (9) credit hours in SOCIOLOGY ELECTIVE COURSES are required.** Courses should be selected from the following:
