

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MINOR DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY

Students must complete a minimum of 18 semester credit hours in Sociology courses.

There are TWO (2) REQUIRED COURSES: SOC 1010 (Intro to Sociology, 3 credit hrs); and **EITHER** SOC 3020 (Social Psychology, 3 credit hrs) **OR** SOC 3030 (Social Structure, 3 credit hrs). Students are strongly encouraged to take both.

An additional twelve (12) elective credit hrs in Sociology are required, of which at least six (6) must be upper division (3000 or above). Elective credits can include SOC 3593 (Criminology Internship) but not individual studies courses (SOC 3950, SOC 3951, SOC 3952).

All courses for the minor must be taken for a letter grade and completed with a “C” (2.0) or better, and students must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 in Sociology courses.
